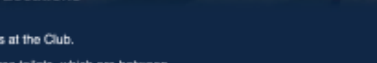


Defibrillator Locations

We have two defibrillators at the Club.

1. Located at the on-course toilets, which are between the 3rd and 13th fairways.
2. Located at the entrance to the men's locker room.

Local Rules

- 1. Out of Bounds** occurs at the following:
 - (a) over the boundaries of the course as defined by the inside line of the fence posts, holes 1 – 9;
 - (b) Curley's Yard between the 3rd and 13th fairways and the adjoining green keeper's car park as defined by white stakes;
 - (c) on or over the service road on Holes 10 – 16, with the exception of the teeing areas on the 10th, 16th, 17th & 18th;
 - (d) the practice ground area to the right of the 18th fairway as defined by a white line; and,
 - (e) under or beyond the innermost point of the railing at the back of the 18th green and the clubhouse enclosure.
- 2. Penalty Areas (Rule 17)**
All drains, wells, ponds and permanent water areas are penalty areas (defined by yellow stakes), or lateral penalty areas (defined by red stakes/lines).
Note: there is no relief without penalty from concrete ducting in a penalty areas.
Hole 18
As defined by red stakes with black tops, from the corner of the dog-leg to the putting green only. Rule 17 allows for relief to be taken within two club-lengths in the general area on the opposite side to where the ball last crossed the penalty area, that is equidistant to the hole.
- 3. Immovable Obstructions (Rule 16.1)**
All artificial immovable objects are deemed immovable obstructions and relief may be taken, without penalty under rule 16.1.
Sprinkler Heads
Relief may be taken under rule 16.1b if the sprinkler head is on the direct line of play and within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball.
- 4. Ground Under Repair – No Play Zones (Rule 16.1f)**
Play from Ground Under Repair (GUR) is prohibited and full relief must be taken.
- 5. Embedded ball (Rule 16)**
Relief under Rule 16.3 allows for free relief to be taken when a player's ball is embedded in the General Area.

Pace of Play

Any group losing a hole should call the following group through immediately. Any group losing a ball must immediately invite the following group to play and if the ball is not found by the time the following group are abreast, allow that group to play through.

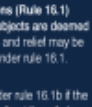

History

Founded in 1885 by Scottish banker and golf enthusiast John Lumsden, The Royal Dublin Golf Club began as a 9-hole course in Phoenix Park. After relocating to Sutton in 1886, the club finally settled on North Bull Island in 1889.

In 1891, the club was officially granted the title of The Royal Dublin Golf Club. During World War I, golf was suspended from 1914 to 1918 as the British army used the land for rifle range training. Remnants of this era remain today, including a bunker on the 6th fairway, originally used for military exercises.



The Royal Dublin Golf Club has a rich history of hosting prestigious tournaments, beginning with the Irish Open in 1894. Since then, over 50 professional and amateur championships have been held at Dollymount, attracting some of the world's finest golfers.

In the 1980s, Royal Dublin hosted the Irish Open for three consecutive years (1983-1985), a period when the event was one of the premier tournaments on the European Tour, just behind The Open Championship. Seve Ballesteros triumphed in 1983 and 1985, while Bernhard Langer took the trophy in 1984.



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
